

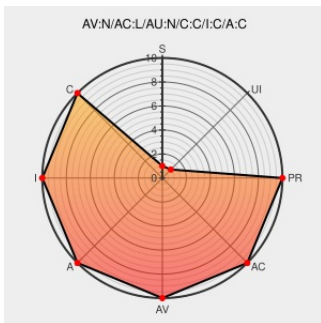

Certain versions of [Http Server](#) from [Apache](#) contain the following vulnerability:

mod_proxy in Apache 1.2.5 and earlier allows remote attackers to cause a denial of service via malformed FTP commands, which causes Apache to dump core.
