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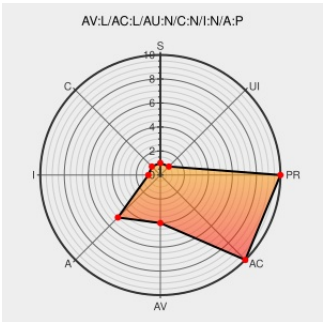

Windows NT 4.0 allows local users to cause a denial of service (crash) via an illegal kernel mode address to the functions (1) `GetThreadContext` or (2) `SetThreadContext`.
