

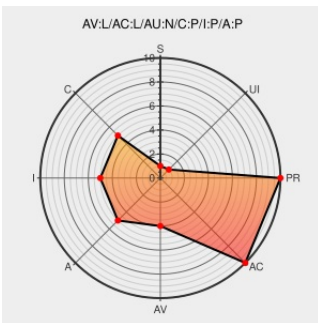

Certain versions of [Bash](#) from [Gnu](#) contain the following vulnerability:

(1) bash before 1.14.7, and (2) tcsh 6.05 allow local users to gain privileges via directory names that contain shell metacharacters (back-tick), which can cause the commands enclosed in the directory name to be executed when the shell expands filenames using the `\w` option in the PS1 variable.
