

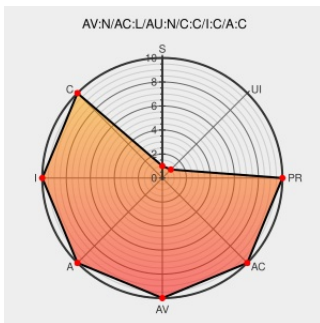

bslist.cgi mailing list script allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary commands via shell metacharacters in the email address.
