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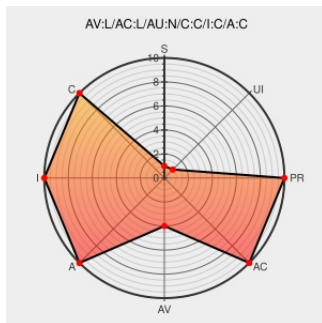
CVE-2001-0190

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Certain versions of [Solaris](#) from [Sun](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Buffer overflow in /usr/bin/cu in Solaris 2.8 and earlier, and possibly other operating systems, allows local users to gain privileges by executing cu with a long program name (arg0).

CVE-2001-0190 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability
