

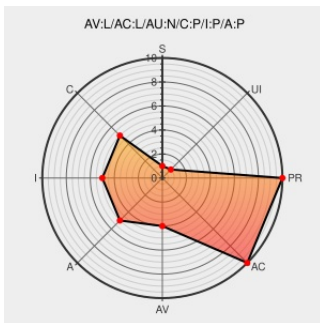

Certain versions of [Bonobo](#) from [Gnome](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Buffer overflow in efstools in Bonobo, when installed setuid, allows local users to execute arbitrary code via long command line arguments.
