

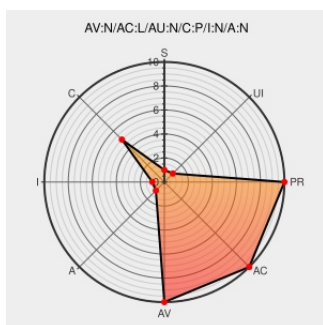

LokwaBB 1.2.2 allows remote attackers to read arbitrary messages by modifying the pmid parameter to pm.php.
