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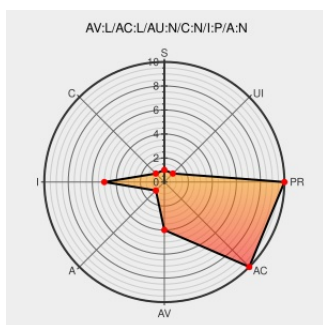

restrictEnabled in Integrity Protection Driver (IPD) 1.2 delays driver installation for 20 minutes, which allows local users to insert malicious code by setting system clock to an earlier time.
