

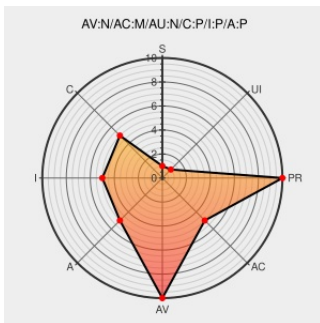

PHP remote file inclusion vulnerability in config.php in Thatware 0.3 through 0.5.3 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary PHP code via the root_path parameter.
