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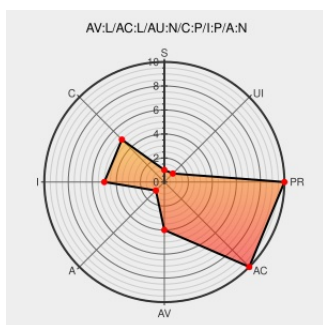

hotfoen4.exe in Hotfoen 4.00 stores user names and passwords in cleartext in the hotfoen2 registry key, which allows local users to gain access to user accounts and steal phone service.
