

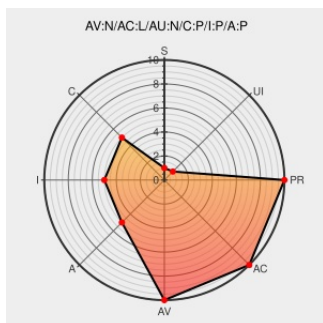

Certain versions of [Slwebmail](#) from [Bvrp Software](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Multiple buffer overflows in SLWebMail 3 on Windows systems allows remote attackers to cause a denial of service and possibly execute arbitrary code via (1) a long Language parameter to showlogin.dll, (2) a long CompanyID parameter to recman.dll, (3) a long CompanyID parameter to admin.dll, or (4) a long CompanyID parameter to

globallogin.dll.
