Description	BlackMoon FTP Server 2.6 Free Edition, and possibly other distributions and versions, generates an "Account does not exist" message when a user attempts to log in with an invalid username and password. This message is displayed in the user interface and is also logged. An attacker could use this information to determine if a user exists in the system, which could be used in a brute force attack.
