Description	Portmon 1.7 and possibly earlier versions allows local users to read and write arbitrary files via the (1) -c (host file) or (2) -l (local file) options. The vulnerability exists because the program does not properly sanitize the input to the system() call, which can be exploited to execute arbitrary code.
