

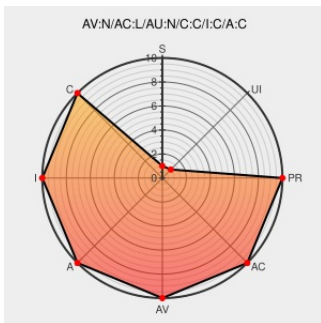

Certain versions of [Solaris](#) from [Sun](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The default installation of `sadmind` on Solaris uses weak authentication (`AUTH_SYS`), which allows local and remote attackers to spoof Solstice AdminSuite clients and gain root privileges via a certain sequence of RPC packets.
