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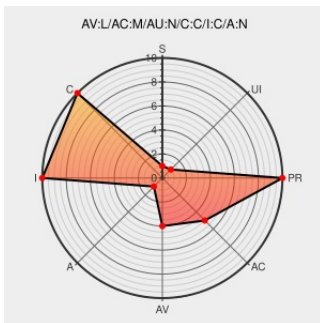

PGPi PGPDisk 6.0.2i does not unmount a PGP partition when the switch user function in Windows XP is used, which could allow local users to access data on another user's PGP partition.
