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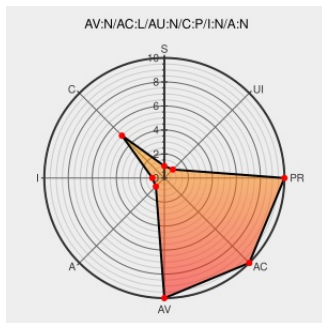

XOOPS 2.0, and possibly earlier versions, allows remote attackers to obtain sensitive information via an invalid xoopsOption parameter, which reveals the installation path in an error message.
