

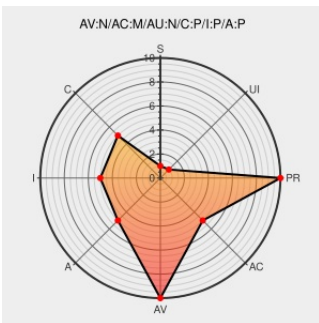

Cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in ArbitroWeb 0.6 allows remote attackers to inject arbitrary script or HTML via the rawURL parameter.
