

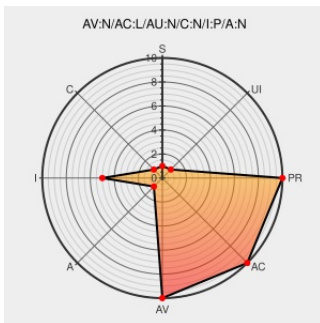

Certain versions of [Safari](#) from [Apple](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Apple Safari 1.0 through 1.2.3 allows remote attackers to spoof the URL displayed in the status bar via TABLE tags.
