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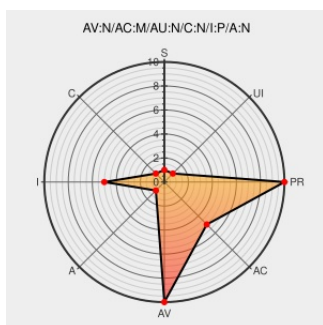

Certain versions of [Mailman](#) from [Gnu](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in the driver script in mailman before 2.1.5 allows remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via a URL, which is not properly escaped in the resulting error page.
