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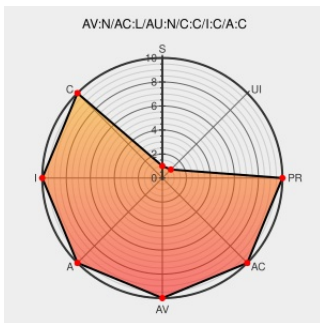

Buffer overflow in the `bsb_open_header` function in `libbsb` for `bsb2ppm` 0.0.6 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary code via crafted BSB pictures.
