

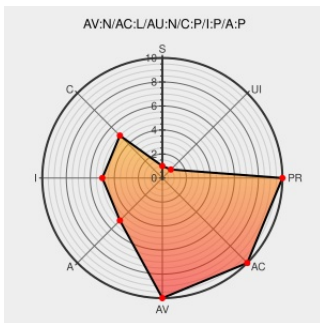

SQL injection vulnerability in index.php in the ibProArcade module for Invision Power Board (IPB) 1.x and 2.x allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the cat parameter.
