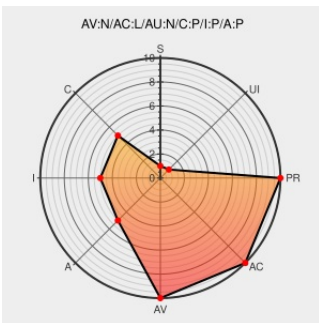

PHP remote file inclusion vulnerability in CuteNews 1.3.6 and earlier allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary PHP code via the cutepath parameter to (1) `show_archives.php` or (2) `show_news.php`.
