

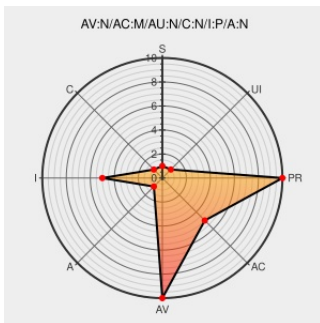

Cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in modules.php in phProfession 2.5 allows remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via the jcode parameter.
