

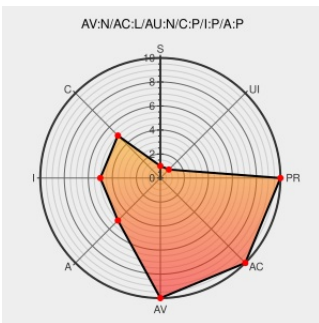

SQL injection vulnerability in pmwh.php in PHPMYWebHosting 0.3.4 and earlier allows remote attackers to modify SQL statements via the password parameter.
