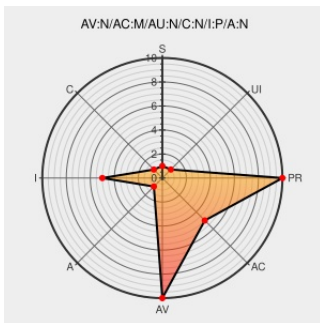

Cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in admin_words.php for phpBB 2.0.6c allows remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via the id parameter.
