

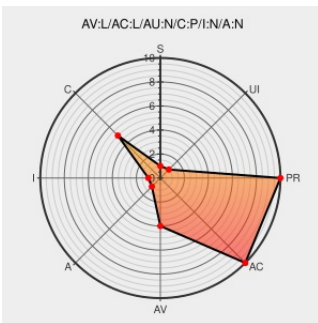

SendLink 1.5 stores sensitive information, possibly including passwords, in plaintext in the data.eat file, which allows local users to gain privileges.
