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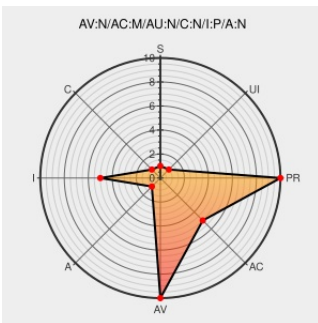

Cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in latek SiteEnable allows remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via (1) the contenttype parameter to content.asp, (2) the title, or (3) the description.
