Certain versions of [Metacart E-shop](#) from [Metalinks](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Multiple SQL injection vulnerabilities in MetaCart e-Shop 8.0 allow remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the (1) intProdID parameter in product.asp or (2) strCatalog\_NAME parameter to productsByCategory.asp.
