

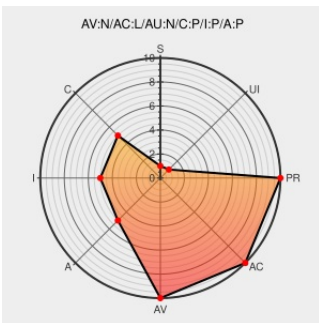

PHP remote file inclusion vulnerability in main.php in osTicket allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary PHP code via the include_dir parameter.
