Multiple cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerabilities in SitePanel 2.6.1 and earlier (SitePanel2) allows remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via (1) the v, show, or sec\_name parameters to main.php, (2) the inadmin, newsev, or postid parameters to 5.php, or (3) the id parameter to 0.php.
