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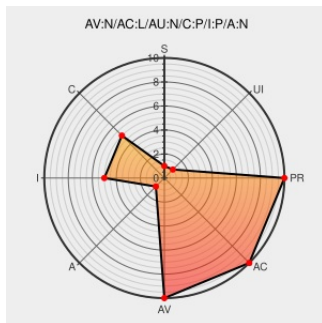

Certain versions of Sitepanel from Sitepanel contain the following vulnerability:

Multiple directory traversal vulnerabilities in SitePanel 2.6.1 and earlier (SitePanel2) allows remote attackers to (1) delete arbitrary files via the id parameter in a rattach action to 5.php, or (2) read arbitrary files via the lang parameter to index.php.
