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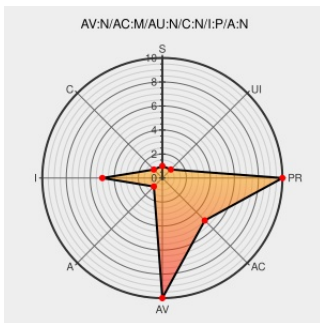

Cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in Skull-Splitter Guestbook 1.0, 2.0 and 2.2 allows remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via the (1) title or (2) content of a message.
