

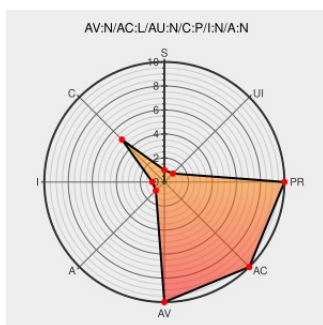

Mercur Messaging 2005 SP2 allows remote attackers to read the source code of .html files via a URL with a trailing hex-encoded space ("%20").
