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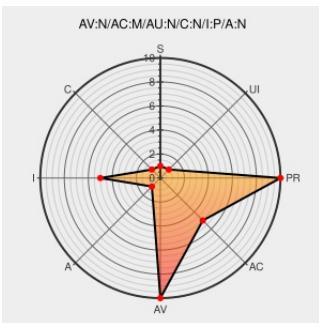

Cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in default.asp for episodex guestbook allows remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via the Name field and other fields.
