

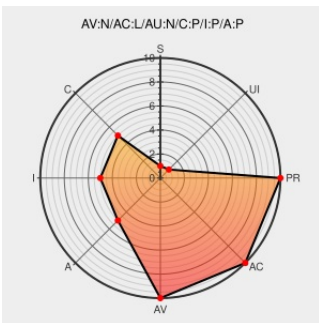

SQL injection vulnerability in login.asp in ezdwc NewsletterEz 3.0 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the password parameter.
