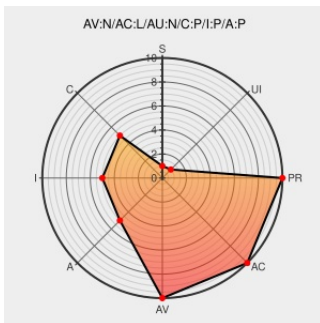

SQL injection vulnerability in login.asp in NEXTWEB (i)Site allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands and bypass authentication via the password field.
