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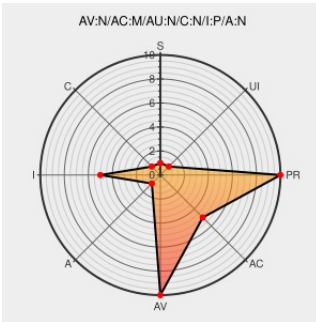

Certain versions of [One Web Server](#) from [Sun](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Sun SunONE web server 6.1 SP1 allows remote attackers to poison the web cache, bypass web application firewall protection, and conduct XSS attacks via an HTTP request with both a "Transfer-Encoding: chunked" header and a Content-Length header, which causes SunONE to incorrectly handle and forward the body of the request in a

way that causes the receiving server to process it as a separate HTTP request, aka "HTTP Request Smuggling."
