

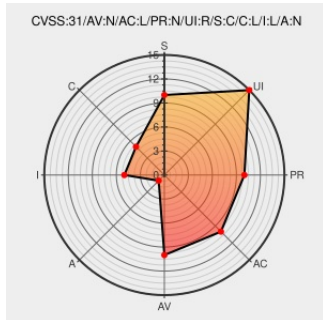

Cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in websieve v0.62 allows remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML code in the web user interface.
