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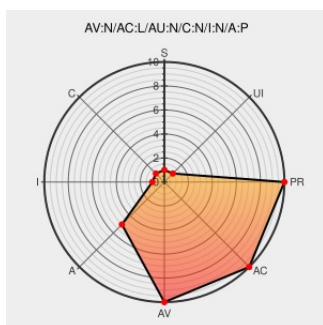

Buffer overflow in Race Driver 1.20 and earlier allows remote attackers to cause a denial of service (application crash) via a long (1) nickname or (2) chat message.
