

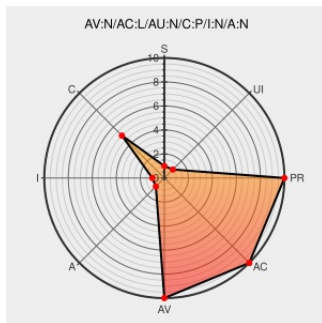

`show_news.php` in CuteNews 1.3.6 allows remote attackers to obtain the full path of the server via an invalid archive parameter.
