

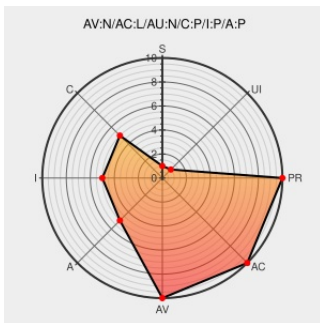

PHP Surveyor 0.98 allows remote attackers to trigger SQL errors via missing parameters to (1) `browse.php`, (2) `export.php`, (3) `conditions.php`, or (4) `spss.php`.
