Certain versions of [Bfcc](#) from [Bfcommand And Control Software](#) contain the following vulnerability:

BFCommand & Control Server Manager BFCC 1.22\_A and earlier, and BFVCC 2.14\_B and earlier, relies on the client to enforce permissions and perform actions such as disconnections, which allows remote attackers to bypass administrative restrictions via a modified client.
