

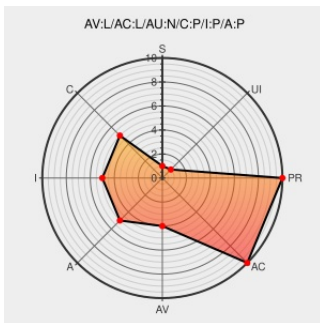

Mercora IMRadio 4.0.0.0 stores usernames and passwords in plaintext in the MercoraClient\Profiles registry key, which allows local users to gain privileges.
