Certain versions of [Kaspersky Anti-virus](#) from [Kaspersky Lab](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Multiple interpretation error in unspecified versions of Kaspersky Antivirus allows remote attackers to bypass virus detection via a malicious executable in a specially crafted RAR file with malformed central and local headers, which can still be opened by products such as Winrar and PowerZip, even though they are rejected as corrupted

by Winzip and BitZipper.
