

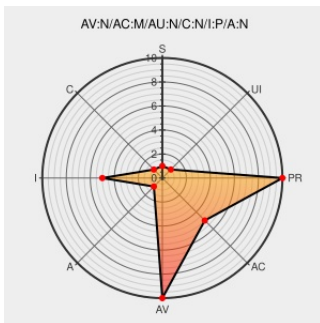

Cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in the Search_Enhanced module in PHP-Nuke 7.9 allows remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via the query parameter.
