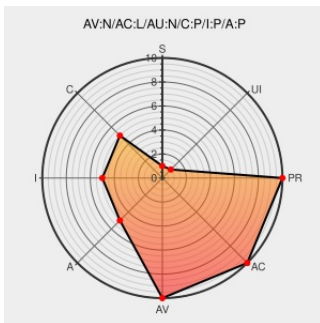

SQL injection vulnerability in forum.php in Orca Forum 4.3b and earlier allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the msg parameter.
