Multiple SQL injection vulnerabilities in ilyav FAQ System 1.1 and earlier allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the (1) FAQ\_ID and (2) action parameters in (a) viewFAQ.php; and (3) CATEGORY\_ID parameter in (b) index.php.
