

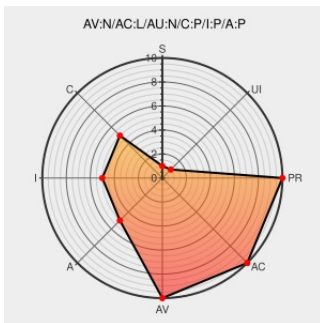

SQL injection vulnerability in session.php in DotClear before 1.2.3 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the dc_xd parameter in a cookie.
