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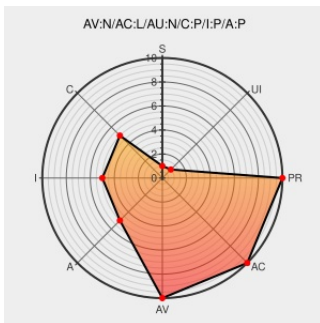

SQL injection vulnerability in view_archive.cfm in CFMagic Magic List Pro 2.5 allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the ListID parameter.
