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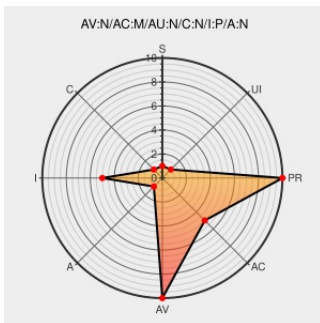

Cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability in getdox.php in Torrential 1.2 allows remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via the URL. NOTE: this might be resultant from CVE-2005-4160.
